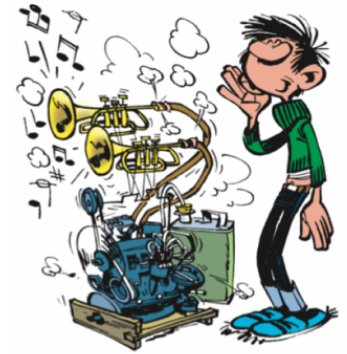




PATENT THE GREATEST INVENTION OF ALL TIME!

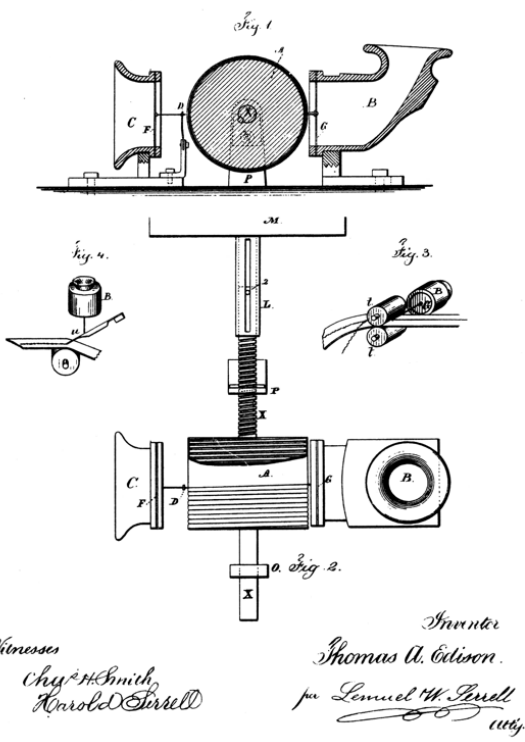
In a world where climate is changing, mankind will have to adapt. Thus, you will have to create a revolutionary invention that will help humanity living on a more hostile Earth.
